Mountain Link Service Begins Monday, August 29

Starting Monday, August 29, Mountain Link will begin service. This new high frequency bus service will link Downtown Flagstaff, NAU and Woodlands Village. The new service is being initiated in conjunction with NAU’s welcome week and will provide students, staff and visitors with a new way to travel to, from and within the campus.

Offering a faster, easier way to travel between downtown Flagstaff, the NAU campus and the Woodlands Village residential and commercial areas, Mountain Link buses run every 10-15 minutes, 14 hours per day on weekdays, and also provide weekend service.

The buses operate on a dedicated transit/bike/pedestrian spine through the heart of the campus, providing direct access to key NAU destinations and a quick link between north and south campus. The basic fare is \$1.25, the same as all Mountain Line routes. Mountain Link is free for NAU students, staff and faculty with their University IDs.

Mountain Link’s hybrid-electric buses incorporate real time arrival technology, which allows passengers to know exactly when the next bus will arrive, and many Mountain Link bus stops are equipped with flat screen monitors with a real time information display.
